Absence Reminder

Illness

If your child is going to be absent from school due to illness, then please inform the school office before 9am in the morning. If your child is off for more than one day, we must still be informed each day of your child's absence until they return to school. Please phone us on 01726 850397 (answerphone 24 hours)

Please leave a message on each day of your child's absence telling us:

1. Your child's name
2. Class
3. Why they are absent (not just unwell)
4. When you expect them to return

Please note in instances of sickness and/or diarrhoea, please keep your child off school for 48 hours, timed from the last occurrence.

Medical Appointments

If you need to take your child out of school for any length of time to attend a medical appointment, the school office must be notified in advance. We also ask to see the letter confirming the date and time of the medical appointment. Please ensure that, where possible, medical appointments are made outside of school time.

Dear Parents, Carers and Families,

My name is Angela Raymer and this term I've taken on the role of Lead Designated Teacher across all CELT schools. I support children in care, those in kinship care or private fostering arrangements, and previously looked after children.

I have a background in working with care-experienced children and this is my absolute passion. I'm really excited to be working across the Trust to make sure that our children have the support they need and have an exceptional educational experience.

Each year, schools can apply for additional funding and resources to support specific groups of students: Children who were in Care, are adopted, or living with you under a Special Guardianship Order or Child Arrangements Order.

If your child was previously in care and is now adopted or living with you under a Special Guardianship Order or Child Arrangements Order, we encourage you to let us know. This allows the school to apply for extra funding that helps meet the social, emotional, and academic needs of children with this background.

To do this, you will need to confirm your child's status by completing a short form here: <https://forms.office.com/e/pTAJ7xRc4k>

The Department for Education requires evidence of your child's status. This can be:

- A copy of the Adoption Order or Special Guardianship Order, or
- A letter from the local authority confirming that your child was placed with you.

This information is recorded in the school census, which is submitted to Cornwall Council and the Department for Education.

Children in Kinship or Private Fostering Arrangements:

If your child lives with you under a Kinship Care or Private Fostering arrangement, we still would like to know. While we cannot claim additional funding for these arrangements, it's important that we understand each child's circumstances to offer the best possible care and support.

Please note: Cornwall Children's Services must be informed of any Private Fostering arrangement. We can support you with this process if needed.
