**Write a letter recommending it to a friend**

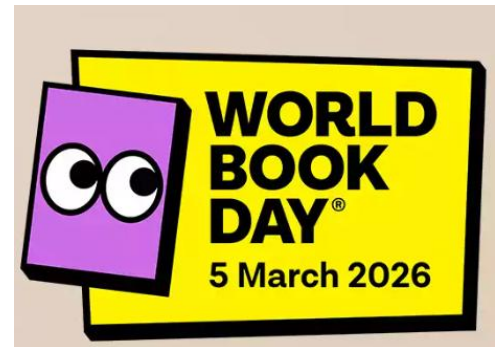
**Create a comic strip of the best bit**

### A letter below regarding the CELT kinship Care Arrangement Survey

A gerens ha withysi ger/Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to share some important information and to invite you to let us know a little more about your family circumstances, if this applies to you.

Some of our learners live with someone other than their birth mum or dad — for example, with grandparents, aunts or uncles, older siblings, or close family friends. This is known as kinship care. These children are not adopted and are not looked after (in care), but they are being cared for by family members or people they already know and trust.

Kinship care can happen for many reasons, including illness, bereavement, family crisis, or other changes in circumstances. These arrangements are often made quickly and quietly, and families do not always think to describe them using formal terms. As a result, schools are not always aware that a child is living in a kinship care arrangement.

Letting us know that your child is living in a kinship care arrangement:

- helps us better understand your child's circumstances
- supports a more informed approach in school
- helps ensure communication and expectations are appropriate
- allows us to reflect on how we support children and families across the school

Sharing this information with us helps us to understand your child and family context more clearly.

If your child lives with you in a kinship care arrangement, or if you are unsure whether this applies to your family, we would encourage you to get in touch using this form:

Dear families,

On Monday, the government announced [its plan for reforming Special Educational Needs and Disabilities \(SEND\) support](#). Many of you will have been very worried about this. You might still be worried.

Today, I want to reassure you. No child in a CELT school will lose the support they already have in place, and we will continue to be on your side to make sure every child who needs support gets it quickly.

The reforms are encouraging. More money to adapt our schools and create new specialist places. More money to train staff. More speech and language therapists and educational psychologists. More help for teachers to make the right choices for each child.

But all of this will take time. New Individual Support Plans won't start until 2030. Until then, nothing will change about the EHCP system.

In the meantime, CELT is not going to sit by and wait for change. We will be a beacon for what is possible everywhere else.

In fact, we are already doing it.

Our **staff training** on inclusive teaching is second-to-none.

Our **Curate and Narrate** document lets all teachers know what each child's needs are.

Our **Adaptive Teaching Toolkit** helps them choose the best ways to help each one succeed.

And our **Student Success Plans** help us work with you to make sure that is happening.

We are also working in partnership with Cornwall County Council to develop additional spaces and provision within our trust.

In short, inclusion is at the heart of what CELT stands for. We are in a great place to lead the way with these reforms.

One plan the government announced yesterday didn't get a lot of attention. They are launching a '**Mission Coastal**' to finally tackle the challenges our communities face.
