### **Important Safeguarding Information – Online 'School Wars' Trend**

We have been made aware, via the Safeguarding Children Partnership and local police, of an emerging online trend known as "school wars." This trend encourages young people to engage in organised fights between groups from different schools. Images like the ones attached have been circulating on social media platforms.

This trend appears to have originated in parts of London and has since been identified in Bristol and areas of North Somerset, with the possibility of becoming more widespread nationally.

Some dates have been shared online (though their accuracy is unknown), suggesting planned "rounds" of activity:

- Round 1 – Friday 27th February
- Round 2 – Monday 2nd March
- Round 3 – Wednesday 4th March
- Round 4 – Thursday 5th March
- Final Round – Friday 6th March

While no specific locations have been identified, we are sharing this information with all parents and carers so you can be aware of the trend, discuss online safety with your child, and encourage them to report anything concerning.
