Absence Reminder

Holidays/Events

We want families to understand how important it is for children to come to school regularly. Learning good attendance habits early in life helps children do well at school and later in their working lives too.

We understand that holidays can be more affordable outside of school holidays, which is why some parents and carers ask for time off during term time. However, we ask all parents and carers to think carefully before taking children out of school, as missing school can affect their learning and progress.

The law says that headteachers can only approve time off during term time in exceptional circumstances. If you take your child out of school for a holiday without permission, you could receive a fine from Cornwall Council.

We ask that parents/carers complete a Leave of Exceptional Circumstance Absence Request Form for any kind of absence (not dentists/doctors/hospital appointments). Please can we receive the completed form at least **15 days** before the start of the planned absence. **Please do not do so or email your request – a form must be completed.**

Appointments

If you need to take your child out of school for any length of time to attend a medical appointment, the school office must be notified in advance. We also ask to see the letter/text confirming the date and time of the medical appointment. Please ensure that, where possible, medical appointments are made outside of school time.

If a medical professional has confirmed that your child will be off school for a longer period, we will do everything we can to support their learning at home.

If it looks like the absence will continue for a while or happens often, we may also get in touch with the local authority to explore options like home tuition to make sure your child doesn't miss out.

- Only book activities that you are able to attend. If your plans change and you can no longer attend, please cancel your booking as soon as possible so another child can take the place.
