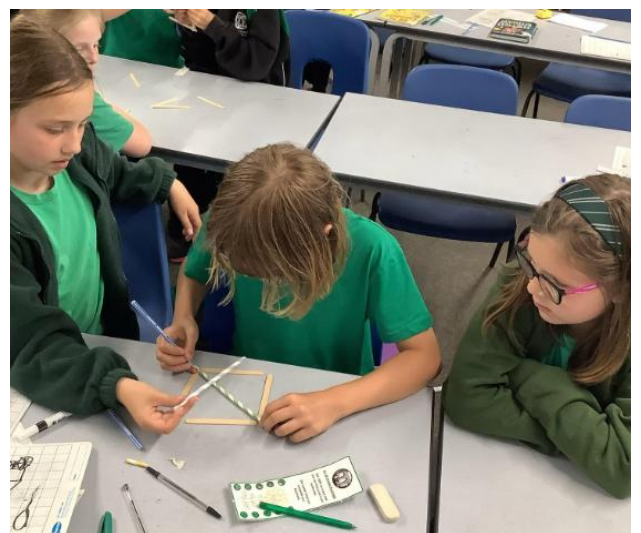
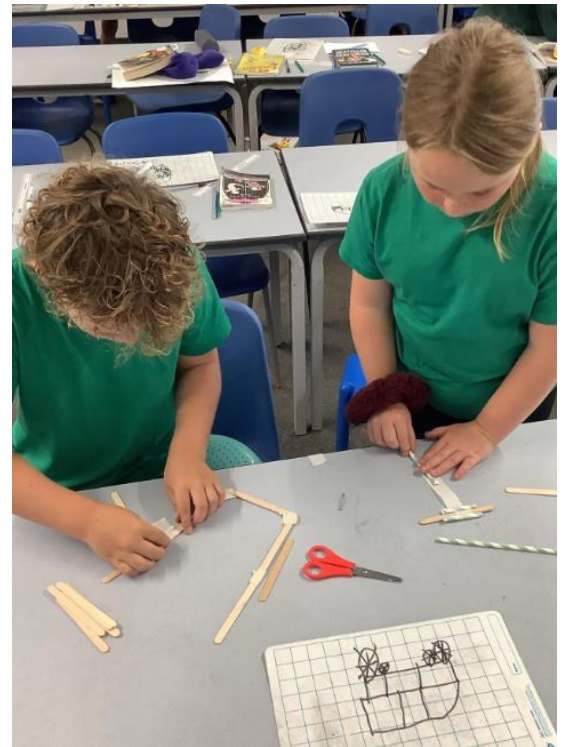

The Great Cornish Show

This year sees the return of the Great Luxulyan Cornish Show on Saturday 18th July from 10.30am to 1pm.

There will be 5 categories this year

Category 1: Piece of art (Cornish themed) – maximum size A3

Category 2: Photograph of somewhere in Cornwall – maximum size A4

Category 3: Cornwall in miniature (3D model) – maximum base size A4

Category 4: Decorated stone (Cornish themed)

Category 5: Best dressed fruit or vegetable (Cornish themed)

Three age groups for each category: 3 to 7, 8 to 12, 13 to 99+

All entries must be clearly labelled with the name and age of the entrant (age only needed if under 16).

Entries can be dropped in between 10.30am and 11.30am. The judging will take place at 11.30am and once this is finished people will be able to come in, see the entries and find out who the winners are. There will also be a raffle with proceeds going to the Cornish Heritage Trust.

The show is part of a wider event happening at school that morning - more details to follow.

After School (Treetops) Wraparound Times

As mentioned earlier in the week we have now had the results of our consultation on wraparound times for our after school provision. We had 75% of respondents opting for a 3:15-4:45pm timing.

You may recall that we undertook this consultation due to very low numbers of pupils between 4:45 and 5:15pm and the financial impact of staffing for this level of uptake.

Therefore, from Monday 15th June we will begin the new offer of 3:15-4:45pm and you will see these booking options on parent pay.

You will be given 2 choices: 3:15-4:15pm at the usual rate of **£5** and then a second booking option of 30 minutes - **4:15-4:45pm** at **£2.50**.

To clarify, next week we will run until 5:15pm but from Monday 15th June our after school provision will change to a new finishing time of 4:45pm.

As with any consultation if we receive an increased demand for later finishing times again then we will review and consult again.
