### **Message from Caterlink: Price Increase**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We want to let you know about a small change to the cost of school meals from the new academic year.

#### **New meal prices**

- Primary: £2.85 per meal (previously £2.70)

If your child receives free school meals, there is no change to their entitlement. The allowance increases in line with the new meal price, so they will continue to receive a meal each day as normal.

#### **Why are prices changing?**

Like many services, school catering has experienced rising costs, including higher food prices and increased staffing expenses. We have made every effort to minimise this increase while still maintaining high-quality meals available daily.

#### **What this means for you**

Your child will continue to receive a nutritious school meal. There is no change in eligibility for free school meals. We are dedicated to supporting all families and ensuring no student is left behind.

#### **Could your child be eligible for free school meals?**

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you receive certain benefits.

If you think you might be eligible, you can apply:

- Through the local authority's website
- Or by contacting the school office, which can help you apply

Applying is quick and confidential and can also help reduce the cost of providing daily lunches, which can add up over the school year.

If you are unsure, we strongly encourage you to check; many families are eligible and don't realise.

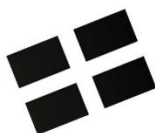

Come and celebrate Cornwall, community and creativity with us. We can't wait to see you there.

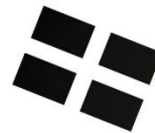
